"Despite attending church services most of my life, I remember one day about eight or nine years ago when I had my most significant spiritual moment. I had been attending services at St. John for about a year or two but I hadn't really put any effort into meeting new people. Our first child was only a few months old and I was in a particularly difficult phase of my career where I was helping people navigate the darkest points of their life. It was emotionally draining and beyond our immediate family, I sought and maintained minimal connections with others. As I was reflecting during a

service, I realized that I was sitting among a group of people who genuinely cared for and loved me. I was reminded of the goodness of people and I felt inspired to spread that to others. For the first time, I had seen God in a group of people. I think about that moment often and it reminds me that what I cherish most about being part of St. John is that its members are genuine, they love and care for each other without motive."
