

night at the age of 17, Kristen attempted suicide by laying down on a set of railroad tracks near her parent's home. She was run over by 33 freight train cars at 50 mph, and both of her legs were severed, miraculously, she survived!! Motivated by the difference that God made in her life, Kristen now shares her personal story and the hope that there is in Christ.




## MISSION SEWING
