IMPROVING HOSPITALITY

In February of 2018 we kicked off The Open Arms capital campaign. The goal of the campaign was to make our facility more inviting by focusing on hospitality. The campaign included a new outdoor digital sign on the corner of the property, refinishing the pews, freshening up the landscaping and updating the narthex. The first two projects have been fully completed. The landscaping project is nearly complete. A few additional plantings will be added in the spring of 2020. The narthex update is also nearly complete. The trim has been painted and new furnishings and wall décor are in place. There are a few additional furnishings to be purchased as well as some updates to the lighting yet to be done.

Part of the campaign has also been to tithe whatever was spent on the facility to ministries outside of St. John. To date we have given \$6000 in support to ministry partners. \$3000 to ELCA World Hunger and \$3000 to Crossways Camps. The Council is currently discerning the recipient(s) of the final tithe once all gifts have been received.

Thank you for your support of this campaign and the improvements it has brought for all of us to enjoy. As the campaign nears its end in January of 2020 our hope is that all pledged gifts will be received. By fulfilling your pledge we will be able to complete the updates to the facilities that we have begun as well as tithe our final gift to a ministry outside of St. John.

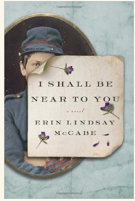

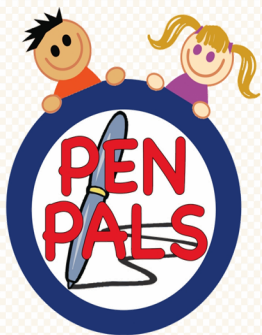

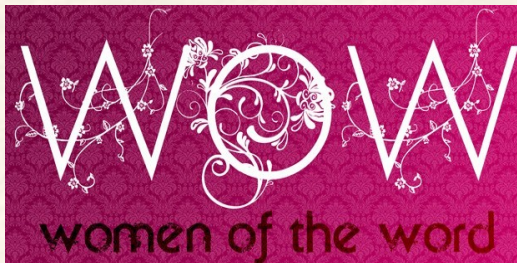
