The Church Council discussed at length during the August meeting, safety protocols for worship and gatherings inside the building in light of the increased community transmission rates for Brown County. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously approved that whenever the rates for Brown county are at or above the "substantial" level as reported on the CDC website, https:// covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/ #county-view

we will require masking while inside the building and Holy Communion will be celebrated using prepackaged wafer/juice picked up as you enter the sanctuary and consumed in your pew. In addition we ask that you respect other's personal space when as is appropriate. inside the building.

We will continue to have the one worship service, indoors, in person on Sunday at 9:00am through the end of September. The service will continue to be live streamed and available afterward on our YouTube channel.

The one exception to worship times will be for the Church Picnic, Sunday, Sept. 12th. <u>The outdoor</u> service will be at 10:30am. The service will not be live streamed or recorded. There will be catered food, games for the kids and music immediately following the worship service.

The Council continues to review vaccination rates and information from health officials and will modify our guidelines and worship services



This story provides the turning point in Mark's gospel. Moreover, Jesus issues a strong challenge to all by connecting discipleship and the cross.
